



**Statement of Compliance with the U.S. Trade Agreements Act (TAA)
Delta Computer Systems, Inc.**

Delta Computer Systems, Inc. dba Delta Motion certifies that its motion controllers and accessory products comply with the requirements of the U.S. Trade Agreements Act (TAA).

Country of Origin Determination

Delta Motion has determined that the country of origin of its motion controllers and accessory products is the **United States**, based on the application of the “substantial transformation” test. Under this test, a product’s country of origin is the country in which it is transformed into a new and different article of commerce with a new name, character, and use.

Basis for Determination

- **PCBs:** Bare printed circuit boards are manufactured in a TAA-designated country.
- **PCBA Manufacturing (U.S.):** PCBs are populated with components in the United States, resulting in a new functional assembly in which individual components lose their separate identities.
- **Firmware:** The firmware is developed and installed in the U.S.
- **Enclosures:** Plastic and metal enclosures are sourced from U.S. manufacturers.
- **Final Assembly:** PCBAs are assembled, integrated, and tested in the United States into complete motion controller products. Cables are transformed from raw cables and connectors to an assembly.

Conclusion

Based on these factors, Delta Motion concludes that its motion control-related products are substantially transformed in the United States and qualify as TAA-compliant.
